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TERMS

Five scholarships will be awarded each spring to offset educational costs for the following school year. Three scholarships will be awarded at one thousand dollars (\$1,000) each. Two scholarships will be awarded at five hundred dollars (\$500) each. The applicant must be a full time student planning on attaining an under-graduate degree for 2 or 4 years at an accredited college, university or trade school recognized by the Portage County Farm Bureau.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must be a resident of Portage County. Applicants must be graduating high school seniors or college students who are reapplying the following year, provided they are pursuing undergraduate studies and have maintained a grade point average of at least 2.5 after the first year. Children of Farm Bureau members will be considered regardless of stated field of intended study. All other applicants will be considered only if they plan to enroll in agriculture or an ag-related field.

APPLICATION

The attached application must be COMPLETED and returned to the Portage County Farm Bureau office no later than March 15th of the current year. A current transcript is required to complete the application, as well as a signature of an authorized school representative. Recipient will be notified in writing, in person by a member of the Board of Trustees, or at the school's awards assembly.

SELECTION

Scholarships will be awarded at the discretion of the Portage County Farm Bureau Board of Trustees. The decision will be based on academic achievement, financial need, extracurricular activities, and other relevant issues. The scholarship recipient will be chosen in May of the current year.
